



MOBILE BAREFOOT KARAVAN TEAM-2

From late March to end April 2012, Heritage Foundation's Mobile Barefoot Karavan Team-2 (MBKT-2) carried out its relentless efforts to Build Back Safer with Vernacular Methodologies, with DRR-compliant sustainable construction in Village *Obayo Mir*, District *Tando Allayar*. In a village that is almost entirely devastated, 52 vulnerable families were helped to build their houses with strong, accessible KaravanRoofs, along with rehabilitation of mud walls. Awareness Campaigns were held for the community to explain the importance of disaster resistance measures, such as the construction of a toe at the base of walls, the use of lime in mortars and plasters and strong accessible roofs. With the completion of the units in the village, community members have learnt methods of Disaster Risk Reduction gaining experience that will create resilient communities. Many others in a community of 350 households, consisting mostly of Hindus, have begun rehabilitation of their devastated mud walls.

Using HF methodology all the selected houses are now complete, where the roofs are strong enough to provide refuge during floods. All the roofs have been tested by households to withstand the load of 15 persons. On her visit to the village in April 2012, CEO, Heritage Foundation was requested by the community to also construct a dispensary and a women's centre. Accordingly, the work on both structures has been undertaken. Support is required at Rs. 80,000 each for a 16' dia dispensary and a women's skill centre, or a total of Rs. 160,000. Any contributions towards the two structures will be gratefully received and the name of the donor(s) will be placed on the two structures.

We would like to extend our thanks to our anonymous donor, Mr. BK, for a donation of Rs. 550,000 for construction of shelters for 52 households, the names of which are provided in the list below. Drawings of each shelter are being prepared (a sample drawing can be seen below), in order to provide a laminated copy to the beneficiaries.

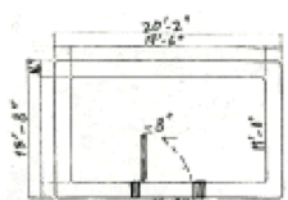

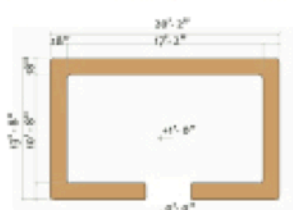

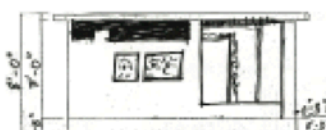
