

HERITAGE FOUNDATION'S SUMMER INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME - 2012

Join the Heritage Foundation Team as it warms up for an exciting summer!

KaravanPakistan is Heritage Foundation's Youth Outreach arm which advocates awareness of Heritage Safeguarding and Disaster Rehabilitation. KaravanVolunteers have been engaged in activities ranging from Heritage Documentation and Facade Cleaning to Post-Disaster and Conflict Rehabilitation.

The Programme

This uniquely modelled 3-week programme is divided into two categories: Heritage and Humanitarian Work. It aims to involve each participant in a focused goal oriented project.

Students have the choice of working on three diverse projects. They are urged to pick a project based on their interest, skills and availability.

The Projects

1. *Post-Flood Rehabilitation Work Lower Sindh*

Students will be travelling to different villages, advocating DRR complaint sustainable construction methodologies. Groups will also monitor and evaluate construction techniques on site and be involved in community strengthening activities. KaravanPakistan volunteer's working on site will receive hands on experience of construction methods and field work in disaster prone areas.

2. *Documentation of Historic Buildings in Saddar Bazaar District, Karachi*

Groups will be divided based on the different streets of Saddar Bazaar District. Each group will undertake research, documentation and development of a Heritage Street character sketch of the region assigned to them. Heritage Facade Cleaning activities and awareness raising campaigns will also be incorporated. The project is geared to create an understanding of the urban fabric of the city of Karachi.

3. *Cataloguing of World Heritage Site 4, The Necropolis of Makli, Thatta*

Participants will be required to travel to Makli, Thatta, where they will embark on the challenge of cataloguing the entire site. A comprehensive study will be developed on the Graves, Tombs, Monuments, and Mosques at the site. Students will also learn about conservation methods during the programme.

Participants will be required to travel to and stay at Heritage Centres in different locations or Sindh. Students must carry basic supplies such as sleeping bags, torches, First Aid kits, clothes and water canteens etc. All expenses for travel, accommodation and food will be borne by the programme. Please note that students will be accompanied by Heritage Foundation Staff and precautions have been taken to ensure safety when out of the city.
